Summary:

The seminar on “Effective Research Paper Writing” commenced with a welcome address by Dr. P. Devaki, Convenor of the programme, organized by the Department of Mathematics at ICT Lab–III, Sri Venkateswara College, University of Delhi. In her address, she highlighted the significance of the seminar for undergraduate students, emphasizing that acquiring research skills at an early stage can shape their academic journey with confidence and clarity. Prof. Swarn Singh encouraged the students to actively engage in the seminar, noting that research plays a vital role in the present education system and is an integral component of a student’s academic growth. Ms. Vaishali formally introduced the resource person, Prof. Ramprakash Sharma, recognized among the top 2% scientists in the world by Elsevier. He serves as a Professor of Mathematics in the Department of Mechanical Engineering at National Institute of Technology Arunachal Pradesh.


The technical session was then conducted by Prof. Ramprakash Sharma, who provided comprehensive insights into the process of writing a research paper. He clearly explained the distinction between a review paper and a research paper. He elaborated on journal classifications such as Q1, Q2, Q3, and Q4, and guided students on identifying suitable journals using SCImago Journal Rank. He also discussed how to evaluate journals based on impact factor, percentile, indexing, and quartile rankings, illustrating his points with relevant examples. Drawing from his own published work, he demonstrated how to effectively draft key components of a paper, including the abstract, graphical abstract, introduction, and references. He further guided students on assessing a journal’s scope, understanding its template requirements, and identifying the appropriate quartile category.



The session concluded with an inspiring motivational note encouraging students to pursue research with dedication and integrity. The programme ended with a formal vote of thanks delivered by Dr. P. Devaki, who expressed her sincere gratitude to the Principal, the Bursar, the Teacher-in-Charge, and the faculty members of the Department of Mathematics for their support in successfully organizing the event.
