# Guideline for students

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS:

- Students may indicate **one or two preferences** from the list of available SRIVIPRA 2025 projects.
- Final selection of students – including the selection method (e.g., interview, written task, or statement of purpose) – will be determined by the faculty mentor.
- Each project will have a maximum of 10 student participants.
- Students must ensure that participation in SRIVIPRA projects does not interfere with their academic coursework.
- Certificates will be issued only to students who demonstrate satisfactory contribution to the project as per the evaluation and discretion of the mentor.
- Students are expected to maintain professionalism, follow timelines, and adhere to research ethics throughout the project duration.

## **CATEGORY A: Internship-Only Project (Non-funded)**

- Duration: 3 months (1st July – 30th September 2025)
- Mode: Online / Offline / Blended
- Certificates will be issued on successful completion of assigned work.
- Key Points:
  - Each project will include a maximum of 10 students.
  - The faculty mentor will determine the final list of selected students based on applications and suitability.
- Students may be involved in tasks like data collection, literature review, field work, or lab-based research.
- A certificate will be provided upon successful completion of the project.

## **CATEGORY B: Minor Research Project with Grant SVPG**

- Duration: 6 months
- Funding: Up to ₹30,000 per selected project
- Mode: Online / Offline / Blended (as decided by the mentor)
- Key Points:
  - Each project will include a maximum of 10 students.
  - The faculty mentor will determine the final list of selected students based on applications and suitability.
- Students may be involved in tasks like data collection, literature review, field work, or lab-based research.
- No stipend will be provided; the grant is meant for research-related expenses only.
- A certificate will be provided upon successful completion of the project.
