
EVENT REPORT

Name of Event: Speaker Session on "Evolution of Global Trade and Investment Framework and

Current Challenges"

Date: 28th February, 2025 Venue: Seminar Hall

The Commerce Association of Sri Venkateswara College hosted an engaging and insightful speaker session featuring Dr. Anup Wadhawan, former Commerce Secretary of India, as the chief guest. The event began with a warm gesture of appreciation for Dr. Vinod Kumar, Convenor, The Commerce Association recognizing his contributions with a memento presented by the core team. He then addressed the audience, emphasizing the importance of discussions on global economic challenges. Following this, Dr. Shruti Mathur, the teacher-in-charge, took the stage, highlighting how Venky encourages a well-rounded education by fostering critical discussions on pressing global issues. Her words set the perfect tone for the session ahead. The annual fest was attended by all faculty members of the Department of Commerce as well as all conveners of various societies of the Department of Commerce.



Mr. Anup Wadhawan began by expressing his gratitude before diving into the topic, "Upheaval in





Global Trade and Investment: Unilateralism in International Trade." He broke down the complexities of global trade wars, India's vulnerabilities in its relationship with the US, and the struggles faced by both developed and developing nations. He took the audience through history, touching upon post-colonial economic challenges and the lasting impact of World War II, explaining how power structures, veto authority, and exclusive global trade policies continue to shape economies today. He also sheds light on inflation, labour issues, gender disparities, and climate concerns, emphasizing how these factors influence trade on a global scale. When discussing India's position, he pointed out its chronic trade deficit and high export elasticity, which make the country heavily reliant on the US market—an economic reality that leaves India in a vulnerable position.

A key highlight of the session was Mr. Anup Wadhawan's analysis of the declining role of the WTO, particularly due to America's withdrawal of support and the impact of Trump's tariff policies. He criticized Trump's economic approach, noting that it was short-sighted, focusing too much on goods while neglecting the services sector, which plays a crucial role in modern economies. He argued that

these policies were not even beneficial for Americans themselves, as they led to economic instability, growing inequity, and a decline in overall welfare. He pointed out how Trump's decisions fueled global trade crises rather than resolving them, while also appreciating Bernie Sanders' stance on economic fairness. Bringing the discussion back to India, he highlighted a sobering fact: over a billion Indians lack surplus resources, making it difficult for India to assert strong leverage in trade negotiations. He concluded by stating that much of what we are witnessing today is not long-term reform, but rather short-term damage control. The session wrapped up with a heartfelt vote of thanks by Mr. Ajit Singh, followed by a moment of appreciation for the people who made the event possible. The core members of all the Commerce Department's societies i.e. ComSoc, Bluechip, Ascend, MAC, Alumni, and Extension—gathered on the podium to honor and share a moment with their respective convenors. It was a fitting end to a thought-provoking session, leaving students with a deeper understanding of the shifting dynamics of global trade and India's role within it.

Name of the Event: IPL Auction

Date: 28th February, 2025

The Commerce Association of Sri Venkateswara College conducted its event "The IPL Auction" on February 28, 2025. The core members of the Commerce Society extended a warm welcome to the participants arriving for the competition.

ROUND 1 - (Quiz Round) The event commenced with an online quiz on Unstop, featuring IPL and cricket-related questions. Out of all the participating teams, 12 teams advanced to the next round.

ROUND 2 - (PlayStation & Franchise Bidding) This round was divided into two parts:

Part A (Play Station Battle) – Out of 12 teams, 8 teams competed in a PlayStation cricket match, with 4 teams qualifying for the final round. Simultaneously, the remaining 4 teams were given direct entry into the final round based on their exceptional performance in the quiz.

Part B (Silent Bidding for Franchise) – The 8 teams then engaged in a silent bidding process to acquire their IPL franchise.

ROUND 3 - (The Bidding Round) The final teams bid and purchased a minimum of 11 players from a pool of 140 players. Teams strategically classified and bid for their best choices within their allotted budgets. An authentic rating system was used to evaluate the constructed teams, with the team having the highest aggregate rating emerging victorious.

Name of the Event- The Vault Heist

The Vault Heist was an electrifying event that blended strategy, financial expertise, and quick decision-making. It took participants on a thrilling journey where every move mattered, and every decision could make or break their path to victory. The event kicked off with Round 1: The Quiz Round, conducted online on Unstop. This round tested participants' knowledge of finance, economics, and business fundamentals. Teams had a limited time to answer the questions, and the top 10 teams advanced to the next stage. The second round, held on campus, was where the intensity picked up. It was divided into three challenging vaults:

Vault 1: The Treasure Hunt - Teams raced to find hidden codes across campus, with the first five teams to unlock the vault securing a higher share of rewards.

Vault 2: The Financial Analysis Puzzle - Participants worked individually to detect errors and fraudulent entries in financial statements. The fastest five were rewarded with a larger share from the vault.
