EVENT REPORT

Name of the event: CONSORTIUM'2026 (Annual Fest)

Date: 12&13 February, 2026

The Commerce Association or ComSoc of Sri Venkateswara College organized its flagship event, annual fest- CONSORTIUM'26, featuring multiple segments that celebrated the spirit of collaboration and innovation. The gathering commenced with the traditional lighting of the lamp and a soulful rendition of Saraswati Vandana, invoking blessings for wisdom and success. A warm welcome was then extended to the esteemed faculty of the Commerce Department, in recognition of their continued guidance and support. The Department of Commerce at Sri Venkateswara College hosted a vibrant and insightful speaker session featuring renowned educator and content creator, Mr. Rajat Arora. The Seminar Hall was packed to capacity with enthusiastic students, creating an atmosphere of palpable excitement and anticipation. The session commenced with a warm welcome for the Chief Guest. Dr. Sindhumani Bag opened the proceedings with introductory remarks. Dr. Vinod Kumar spoke on the collective efforts of the commerce societies (ComSoc, Bluechip, MAC, Ascend, Extension Society, and Commerce Alumni Connect).

The ComSoc Convenor, Dr. Vinod Kumar, then took the stage to share a few words that set the tone for the day. In his address, he spoke about the collaborative spirit and dedication that drive the Commerce Department, and acknowledged the efforts of students and faculty in making Comfluence a meaningful platform. He then introduced the guest speaker, **Mr. Rajat Arora**, an educational entrepreneur who has transitioned into the field of commerce highlighting the relevance of interdisciplinary learning and the value of diverse perspectives in today's professional landscape. **Mr. Rajat Arora**, a renowned teacher and entrepreneur graced the event as the guest speaker. He spoke about his transition from college graduate to entrepreneurship, his expertise in accounting, and his impactful work in the educational coaching sector. The session was deeply motivational and left a lasting impression on both students and faculty alike. A member of the Alumni Connect as faculty in the Department of Commerce, SVC shared her personal professional journey, offering a localized perspective on the versatility of the commerce stream. She emphasized that the scope of commerce is far broader than traditional perceptions suggest. Following her address, she was presented with a token of appreciation by Dr. Sindhumani Bag. The Dr. Vinod Kumar expressed his deep sense of gratitude to ComSoc members from faculty Dr. M. Rama Naik, Ms. Angel Josy Lakra and faculty members Ms. Sunita Chhabra, Dr. Shruti Mathur, Dr. Pooja Jain, Dr. Davendra Malapati, Dr. Arpita Kaul, Dr. Antima Sharma, Dr. P. Chengalrayulu, Mr. Ajit Singh for giving their valuable time and attending the event. In addition to this, we expressed our deepest gratitude to our principal Prof. Vajala Ravi, Vice Principal Prof. (Dr.) Nandita Narayanasamy and all faculty members of the Department of Commerce.

SPEAKER SESSION

After a brief presentation by Team Ascend, Mr. Rajat Arora took the podium. His session was a mix of personal anecdotes, career strategy, and life lessons. He candidly shared his transition from the Science stream to Commerce, highlighting the hardships he faced and how pivoting allowed him to find his true calling. He urged students to prioritize tangible skills and entrepreneurship, specifically touching upon the evolving role of AI in the modern professional landscape. A significant portion of his talk focused on the "Modern Trio" of success, building a robust C.V., maintaining a strong social media presence, and mastering a niche skill. He encouraged the habit of reading newspapers daily, noting that staying informed is the cornerstone of building meaningful professional connections. Addressing the student demographic directly, he spoke about the pitfalls of "FOMO" (Fear of Missing Out) in relationships and the importance of time management during college years. The session was deeply motivational and left a lasting impression on both students and faculty alike. The floor was opened for a Q&A session, where students engaged directly with Mr. Rajat Arora on topics ranging from career shifts to content creation. Despite a minor medical inconvenience where a student briefly fainted (and was promptly attended to and recovered), the event proceeded smoothly. The session concluded with remarks from Ms. Angel Josy Lakra, gave vote of thanks which was followed by a formal felicitation ceremony to honor the guest speaker and the organizing teams.



First Event: MYSTIC FORUM

The Mystic Forum was a one of a kind event, combining real problem solving and analytical skills with a mythical based setting. The competition unfolded in multiple rounds, beginning with an online quiz that evaluated participants' aptitude along with general and financial knowledge. The top 8 teams advanced to the offline deck submission and presentation round where: Case Cope, Iron Root Covenant, Horsefire T, Covenant of Stability, The Sap of Life, Chhole Bhatore, Payers, and The Consulting Cult.

These teams were given a crisis problem about a mythical nation called Aethelgard, which was suffering from lack of resources and civil war, judging their moral, authoritative and long-term financial planning capabilities. All the participants proposed innovative and practical solutions to the crisis, with each of them having their own special and creative approach towards problem-

solving. The participants were also allowed to ask questions from the presenting teams, and the level of the questions contributed to the overall points of the questioning team. This presentation round was followed by a final escape room round, where participants had to solve aptitude and mythical culture based riddles mixed with financial problems twist, which included franchises like The Lord of the Rings, Harry Potter, Wednesday, Game of Thrones and Vampire Diaries. The round tested general pop culture knowledge of the participants along with on-the-spot decision-making. The overall result depended on a combination of the performance in both the presentation and the escape room rounds. After an intense and insightful series of presentations, back-to-back questions and brain twisting riddles, Team Horsefire T (Netaji Subhash Institute of Technology & Indraprastha University) emerged as the winners, with Sap of Life (Sri Venkateswara College) and Case Cope (Shri Ram College of Commerce) being the first and second runner ups respectively. Each of these teams impressed the judges with their creativity and innovative approach to problem-solving, their strategic questions to other teams and a speedy escape from the escape room.

Second Event: The Perfect Escape

The Perfect Escape was a fun and interactive game-based event organised by the Commerce society. The event was designed to test teamwork, thinking skills, decision-making, and how well participants could perform under pressure. The entire game was divided into different rounds called *vaults*, with a few gamble and surprise rounds in between to keep things exciting.

Vault 1 – Treasure Hunt

The first round was a treasure hunt. Teams had to move around different locations to collect clues. At each location, a society member was present with a clue. The goal was to collect all the clues as quickly and accurately as possible. This round focused a lot on coordination, communication, and speed.

Gamble Round

After the treasure hunt, a gamble round was conducted. In this round, teams had the chance to either increase or lose their points or cash based on their decisions. This added an element of risk and made the game more interesting.

Vault 2 – Murder Mystery

The second vault was a murder mystery round. Teams were given clues and had to connect them to solve the mystery. Logical thinking, discussion, and teamwork were very important in this round.

Split and Steal Round

Following Vault 2, a split and steal round took place. In this round, team members had to make choices between sharing rewards or choosing personal gain. This round tested trust and teamwork within the teams.

Vault 3 – Bribing the Watchmen

Vault 3 involved solving puzzles by bribing watchmen using the resources teams had earned in previous rounds. Teams had to think smartly about how to use their resources while solving the puzzles. This round focused on both problem-solving and strategy.

Split and Steal Round

Another split and steal round was conducted after Vault 3, adding more pressure and excitement to the game.

Vault 4 – Investment Round

Vault 4 was an investment-based round. Teams had to decide where and how much to invest their earned cash. The results depended on their choices, making this round all about planning and risk-taking.

Gamble Round

After the investment round, another gamble round was held. This gave teams one last chance to change their position in the game.

Final Round – Escape Room (Surprise Round)

The final round was a surprise escape room challenge. This round was not revealed beforehand. Teams were given clue sheets with riddles, and the clues were hidden around them. They had to solve the riddles and find the final answer to escape. The team that completed the task first was declared the winner.

The Winner was- **TEAM ARJUN**

Conclusion

The Perfect Escape was a well-organised and exciting event. The mix of different types of rounds, along with the surprise escape room at the end, kept participants engaged throughout. Overall, the event was enjoyed by everyone and successfully tested teamwork, thinking skills, and decision-making.

Event Third: The Talent Hunt

The Talent Hunt at Consortium was a lively and engaging showcase of creativity, bringing together students from across the campus to celebrate their diverse skills. The event featured an array of performances, including freestyle dance, rap, soulful singing, and several unique acts that highlighted the individuality and passion of the participants.

With enthusiastic participation and an energetic audience, the Talent Hunt created an atmosphere of excitement and camaraderie. It not only entertained but also provided a platform for students to express themselves, gain recognition, and strengthen the cultural spirit campus. The event stood out as a true celebration of talent and community, leaving a lasting impression on everyone present.

Fourth Event: BRANDXCHANGE
