EVENT REPORT

The Annual Fest, NIVESH'25 organised by the Finance and Investment Cell (Bluechip) kicked off with three competitions- Profit over people, Cluedo: Murder on Dalal Street and Beyond Unicorns in the room nos. 301, 302 and Seminar Hall at the Sri Venkateswara College, DU. The details of each competition is as under: **Profit over People: The Mock Stock Competition**

The Profit over People was a fast-paced and strategic mock stock market competition that tested participants on their financial acumen, quick decision-making, teamwork, and presentation skills. The event had three rounds, each bringing new challenges and excitement. It began with an online quiz, where teams answered questions on stock markets, business fundamentals, valuation, and current financial trends. From this round, 12 teams moved ahead to the next stage. In the second round, these teams were given a simulated market scenario with economic news, sector updates, and company developments. They had to build and manage a portfolio, decide entry and exit points, and aim to maximize their share price value while managing risks. From here, 5 top teams with the highest portfolio valuation were selected for the final round. In the final round, participants had to create and present a detailed investment strategy or launch a mock company with justified financial projections within a limited time. They were judged on profitability, risk analysis, market understanding, presentation quality, and how well they justified their projected share price growth. All the strategies were evaluated by esteemed judges, who praised the participants for their analytical thinking and innovative financial approaches.

Cluedo: Murder on Dalal Street

It was designed to combine financial literacy with investigative reasoning through an immersive murder mystery format set in the backdrop of India's stock market landscape. The aim was to encourage participants to apply core financial concepts in a simulated high-stakes scenario while enhancing teamwork, analytical thinking, and strategic decision-making skills. It commenced with an online preliminary quiz consisting of finance and market-oriented questions to shortlist the most competent teams. The top 10 teams were selected and invited to compete in the on-campus finale, where two teams ultimately emerged as winners.

It was a real-life adaptation of the classic deduction game Cluedo, reimagined within the dynamic environment of Dalal Street. Participants assumed the role of financial investigators tasked with solving a high-profile corporate crime involving elements such as insider trading, market manipulation, and financial fraud. Teams were required to examine clues, interpret financial data, question suspects, and connect logical evidence to uncover the culprit. The challenge lay in balancing time management with precise reasoning, creating an engaging and intellectually stimulating competitive atmosphere.

The event received enthusiastic participation and witnessed exceptional analytical performances from the finalists. Students demonstrated strong critical thinking, financial awareness, teamwork, and quick decision-making under pressure. The intensity of the investigation rounds kept participants deeply engaged, and after rigorous evaluation, two teams were declared winners for their outstanding analytical clarity and strategic approach. It proved to be a unique and innovative event that redefined traditional finance competitions by integrating immersive storytelling with real-time deduction elements. The event not only

assessed participants' financial aptitude but also their analytical depth and collaborative intelligence, making it one of the most memorable and impactful highlights of the fest.

Beyond Unicorns: The Business Plan Competition

It was a dynamic and forward-thinking business plan competition that tested participants on their entrepreneurial mindset, financial planning, innovation, and pitching skills. The event focused on turning bold ideas into practical, real-world business models. It began with an initial screening round, where teams submitted a brief concept note outlining their startup idea, target market, and revenue model. Based on feasibility, originality, and scalability, shortlisted teams advanced to the next stage. In the second round, participants were required to develop a detailed business plan, including market research, operational strategy, financial projections, and growth roadmap. Teams refined their ideas to ensure they were realistic, sustainable, and investment-worthy. In the final round, teams presented their complete business plan before the judging panel in a formal pitching session. Each team had to justify their valuation, revenue streams, cost structure, and long-term vision. The round also included an intense cross-questioning segment, where judges challenged assumptions, tested financial clarity, and evaluated real-world applicability. At the end of the competition, one outstanding team secured an investment of ₹15,000 for their venture, recognizing the strength, feasibility, and impact of their idea. Overall, Beyond Unicorns proved to be an insightful and empowering experience that encouraged participants to think beyond billion-dollar valuations and focus on building practical, sustainable businesses rooted in real-world problem solving.

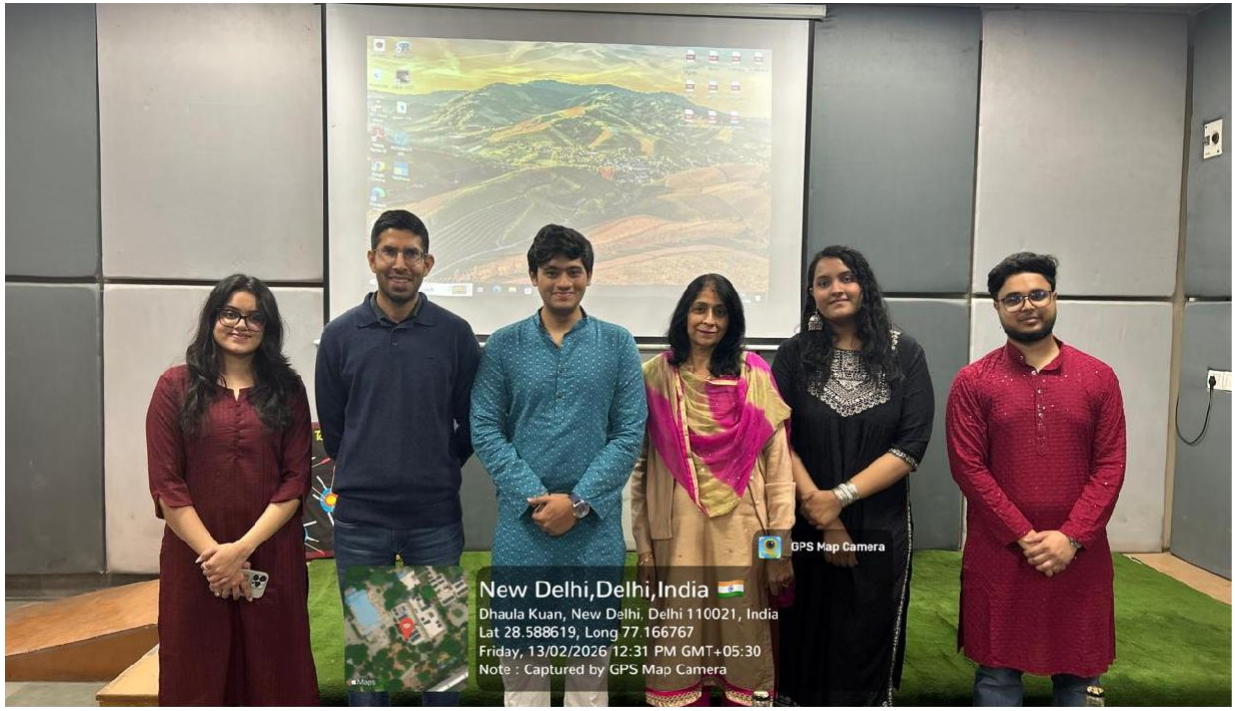
