OBJECTIVES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">To cultivate critical thinking and structured problem-solving skills among participants by engaging them with real-world social challenges.To encourage ethical reasoning and strategic decision-making under conditions involving constraints and trade-offs.To promote responsible innovation by fostering feasibility awareness, accountability, and reflective judgment among students.
METHODOLOGY	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Formal Competition: Participants formed teams of 2–3 members and competed in a three-round structured challenge simulating real-world decision-making. Teams developed and pitched solutions to a given problem, faced an irreversible Trade-Off constraint, and critically examined the limitations of their own ideas in the final round. Judges evaluated feasibility, ethical clarity, and strategic reasoning throughout the event.

Event Report

Think Tank: The Reality Edition

The Extension Society of Sri Venkateswara College, University of Delhi, successfully organized *Think Tank: The Reality Edition* as a flagship competition under Nirvana'26. The event was designed as an immersive platform to simulate real-world decision-making scenarios, emphasizing critical analysis, ethical reasoning, and strategic trade-offs rather than conventional persuasive pitching.

Conducted in offline mode on campus, the competition was structured into three progressive rounds, each evaluating distinct dimensions of problem-solving and intellectual maturity.

The event commenced with **Round 1: Problem Drop and Pitch Preparation**, wherein participating teams were provided with a real-world problem statement and allotted 15–20 minutes to develop a structured solution framework. Each team presented its idea in a concise two-minute pitch. Judges observed without interruption to ensure fairness and equal opportunity. Evaluation focused on clarity of thought, logical structuring, and depth of understanding.

The competition advanced to **Round 2: Trade-Off Auction Round**, introducing a strategic constraint element. Each team randomly selected a Trade-Off Card presenting two mutually exclusive priorities, such as *Autonomy versus Funding* or *Innovation versus Reliability*. Teams were required to choose one option within a limited deliberation period while permanently forfeiting the other. This decision became binding for the remainder of the competition. Participants justified their choice and analysed the operational and strategic limitations arising from the selected constraint. Judges actively engaged with teams to assess feasibility, sustainability, and consequence awareness.

The final stage, **Round 3: "Don't Convince Me" Round**, required teams to critically evaluate the limitations, risks, and ethical implications of their own proposals. Judges simulated real-world stakeholders and presented practical constraints and probing questions. Participants were discouraged from over-promoting their ideas and were instead assessed on intellectual honesty, reflective judgment and accountability. As a concluding exercise, teams were asked whether, after acknowledging all risks and constraints, they would still proceed with their proposed solution.

The final evaluation was based on cumulative performance across all rounds, ensuring holistic assessment. Think Tank: The Reality Edition successfully shifted the focus from idealistic innovation to responsible and reality-based evaluation, encouraging students to engage deeply with feasibility, trade-offs, and ethical considerations.

Through this competition, The Extension Society reinforced its commitment to nurturing critically aware and socially responsible changemakers, providing participants with meaningful experiential learning in structured decision-making under constraints.

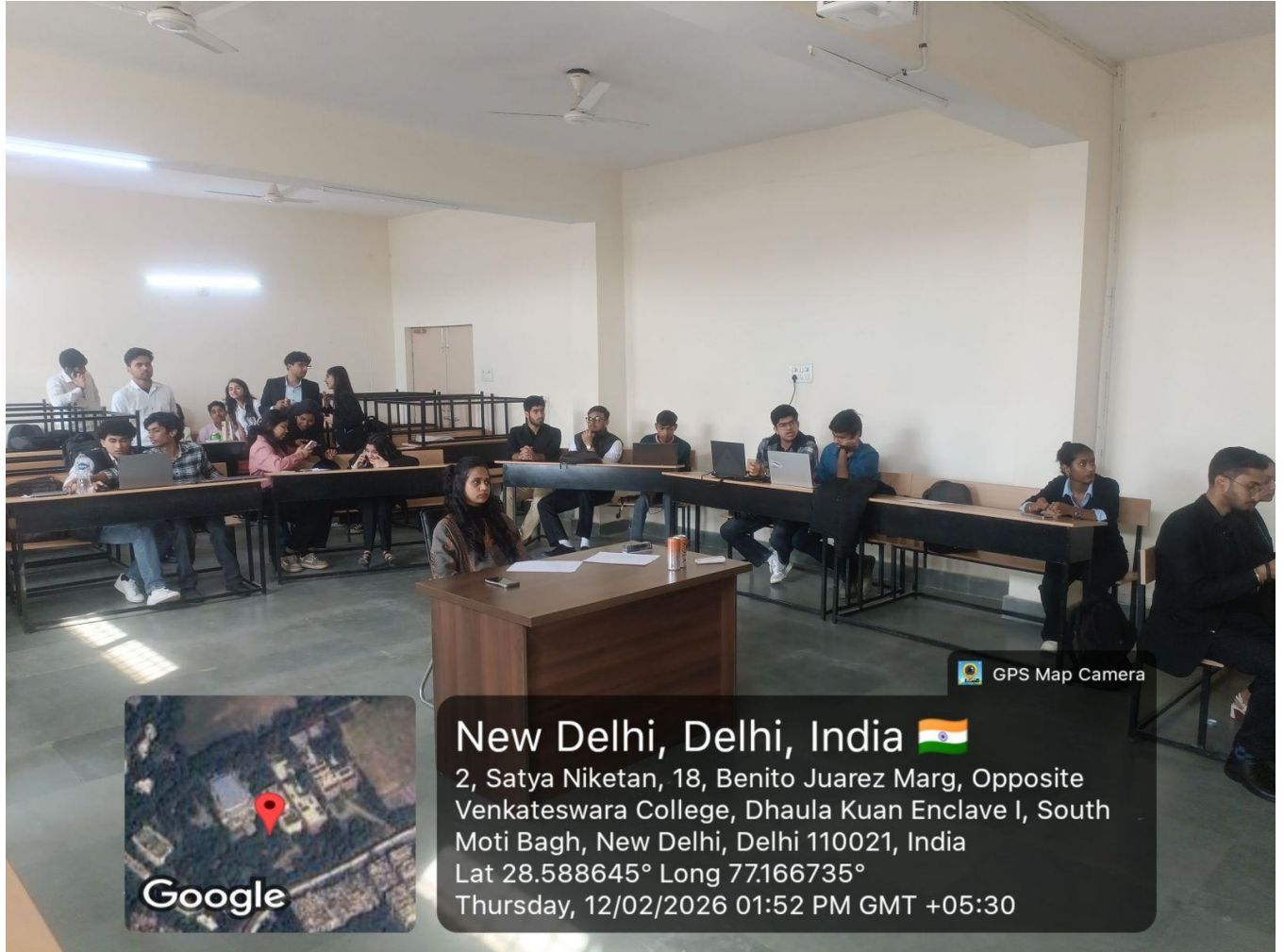

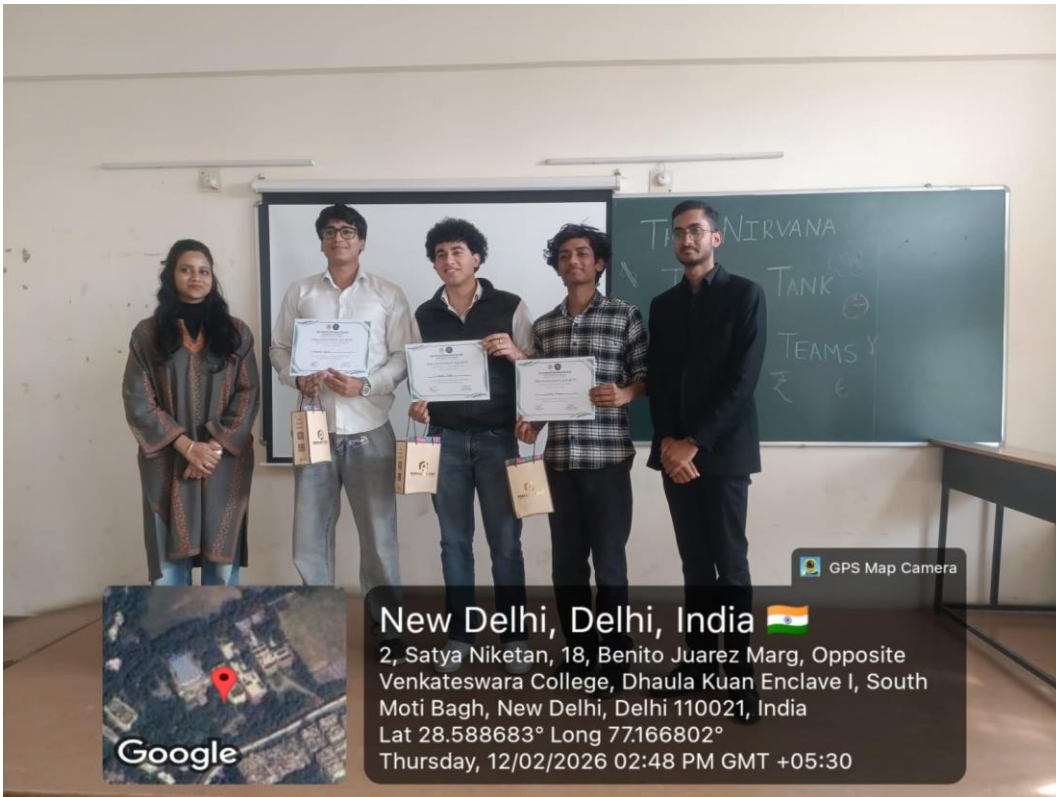

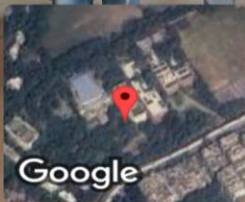
