

OBJECTIVES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● To raise awareness about gender rights and legal structures that impact women and marginalized communities.● To highlight the contributions of women in shaping legal and social progress, emphasizing the need for equal representation in the judiciary.● To discuss conflicts between religious freedoms and gender justice, aiming to find a balance that upholds women's rights.● To emphasize the importance of feminist literature and legal texts in understanding gender biases within the legal system.

METHODOLOGY	<p>Expert speakers Sister Mary Scaria and Dr. Shalu Nigam provided insights on gender justice, legal reforms, and social change. The event included discussions on women's Contributions to legal and social progress, structural barriers in the judiciary, and the historical role of women in shaping constitutional rights. Open discussions allowed participants to engage with the content and reflect on gender inequalities within the legal framework.</p>

OUTCOMES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Recognition of Women's Legal Contributions: The session highlighted how women's efforts in law and governance have been historically overlooked, Reinforcing the need to acknowledge and document their achievements. ● Awareness of Gender Bias in the Judiciary: The discussion addressed the under representation of women in the legal system and the necessity of structural reforms to ensure fair representation. ● Understanding the Conflict between Gender Justice and Religious Freedoms: The session shed light on the Complexities of balancing religious liberties with gender rights in legal frameworks. ● Inspiration to Challenge Patriarchal Norms :Participants were encouraged to critically examine and challenge gender-based discrimination in both personal and professional spaces. ● Engagement with Feminist Legal Texts: The session emphasized the importance of engaging with feminist literature to build a deeper understanding of legal gender biases and justice.

Brief Report:

On 8 March 2025, On the occasion of International Women's Day, the Women Development Cell of Sri Venkateswara College, Delhi University, organized a discussion on gender rights and legal structures, coordinated by Dr. Ritika Singh, Dr. Niharika Jaiswal, and Ms. Angel Josy Lakra, with Principal Prof. V. Ravi as Chief Patron. The event featured Sister Mary Scaria and Dr. Shalu Nigam.

Sister Mary, a Supreme Court advocate, human rights activist, and educator, has authored over 20 books on law, feminism, and minority rights. She serves as Honorary Secretary of the Constitutional Cause and President of the People's Initiative for Legal Literacy. Dr. Nigam, a feminist lawyer and researcher, has worked extensively on gender and governance. As the petitioner in *Shalu Nigam vs. Regional Passport Officer* (2016), she set a precedent for women's rights. Their insights enriched discussions on gender justice, legal reform, and social change. The discussion offered insights to the every day struggles and ongoing efforts in the court rooms to lead to a future with gender sensitized society. The gender based unfair treatment of women in professional spaces and their own homes brought over a rush of motivation to work harder and more rigorously to improve our legal structures for the welfare of upcoming generations. The participants were taken back in time to the relentless journey of women in the extremely biased society who drove the law to include and recognize women's rights and autonomy and brought us to where we are today. This filled the participants with pride for the women that history remembers so little of, and in honour of the day, to make those women's efforts payoff by continuing their journey forward. It inspires participants to continue advocating for reforms that ensure justice and equal rights for all genders, making the efforts of past generations meaningful and impactful for the future.
