METHODOLOGY	A panel discussion was organized on August 26 at Sri Venkateswara College. The event was a joint effort by the NEP Saarthi Committee and the Department of Sanskrit. Held in the V. Krishnamurthy Block from 11:45 AM to 2:30 PM , the program was coordinated by Dr. Neelam Kumari and Dr. Ravi Kumar Meena under the guidance of Principal Prof. Vajala Ravi. It began with a traditional lamp lighting ceremony and featured panelists from various departments.

1. Event Description and Pictures

On August 26, Sri Venkateswara College hosted a panel discussion on the "Indian Knowledge System (IKS)". The event was a joint initiative of the college's NEP Saarthi Committee and the Department of Sanskrit. Held from 11:45 AM to 2:30 PM in the V. Krishnamurthy Block, the program aimed to shed light on the integration of IKS into the new academic curriculum as envisioned by the NEP 2020. The discussion was conducted under the guidance of the college principal, Prof. Vajjala Ravi, and coordinated by Dr. Neelam Kumari and Dr. Ravi Kumar Meena.

The event began with the ceremonial lighting of the lamp and a 'Mangalacharan' (invocation). Following this, the conveners informed the students about initiatives from the Ministry of Education's IKS division, encouraging both students and teachers to take advantage of schemes like the establishment of IKS centers, research proposals, scholarships, and internship opportunities. It was also announced that the UGC recently released a draft Learning Outcome-based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) for nine subjects, which specifically includes IKS and invites suggestions from all stakeholders.

A diverse group of scholars from various departments served as panelists to enrich the discussion. The panel included Dr. Jitendra Vir Kalra (Hindi Department), Dr. Ravi Kumar Meena (Sanskrit Department), Dr. Mohita Bhagat (Zoology Department), Dr. Praveen (History Department), and Dr. M. Krishna Rao (Sanskrit Department). They highlighted the relevance of IKS in diverse fields such as literature, ethics, Ayurveda, chemistry, and mathematics.

The experts provided practical examples to integrate traditional knowledge with modern education. For instance, they explained concepts like number systems and the Pythagorean theorem from an IKS perspective. The importance of Ayurveda was also a key topic, described not just as a tradition but as a "science of life" that connects eternal knowledge with modern research. It was noted that innovations like Ayurgenomics could help India lead the global holistic healthcare sector.

The panel discussion concluded with a lively question-and-answer session. Students actively participated, asking questions and sharing their views on the review, revival, and reinvention of IKS. The event successfully fostered a deeper appreciation for India's rich knowledge heritage and its relevance in today's educational landscape.
