The debate was evaluated based on criteria such as understanding of the subject, clarity of thought, critical analysis, and originality of ideas.

3. Event Description and Pictures

The "NEP 2020 Debate Competition," an initiative of the NEP SAARTHI Committee at Sri Venkateswara College, was conducted on September 9, 2025, in Room No. 57 of the V. Krishnamurthy Block, commencing at 11:45 AM. The competition aimed to actively involve the student body with the tenets and anticipated implementation of the National Education Policy 2020. Prior to the event, interested students were required to register via an online Google Form, facilitating a streamlined organizational process. On the day of the competition, registered participants convened at the designated venue, where they were provided with the necessary instructions and guidelines.

The debate session proceeded in a focused and academic environment. Students thoughtfully addressed the broad theme of engaging with the vision and implementation of NEP 2020, drawing upon their understanding of the policy's objectives and potential impact. The speeches delivered during this period reflected a spectrum of interpretations and analyses, demonstrating varying levels of engagement with the policy's multifaceted

dimensions. The jury panel comprised of Prof. Nandita Narayansamy and Prof. Muktikant Sukla. The assessment process focused on criteria such as the clarity of argumentation, the depth of comprehension of NEP 2020, the rigor of critical analysis, and the originality of the insights presented by the participants.

The Debate Competition was concluded with the announcement of the winners: Aditya Das (2nd Year, B.A. Economics Hons.) was awarded Best Interjector, while the winning team, Team Manthan, comprising Shambhavi and Tanushree Joshi secured the first position. The runner-up team was Perna, comprising of Vandana Sharma and Ajay.

The competition successfully provided a platform for students to articulate their understanding and critical thinking about the National Education Policy, contributing to a greater awareness and engagement with this significant educational framework within the college community.



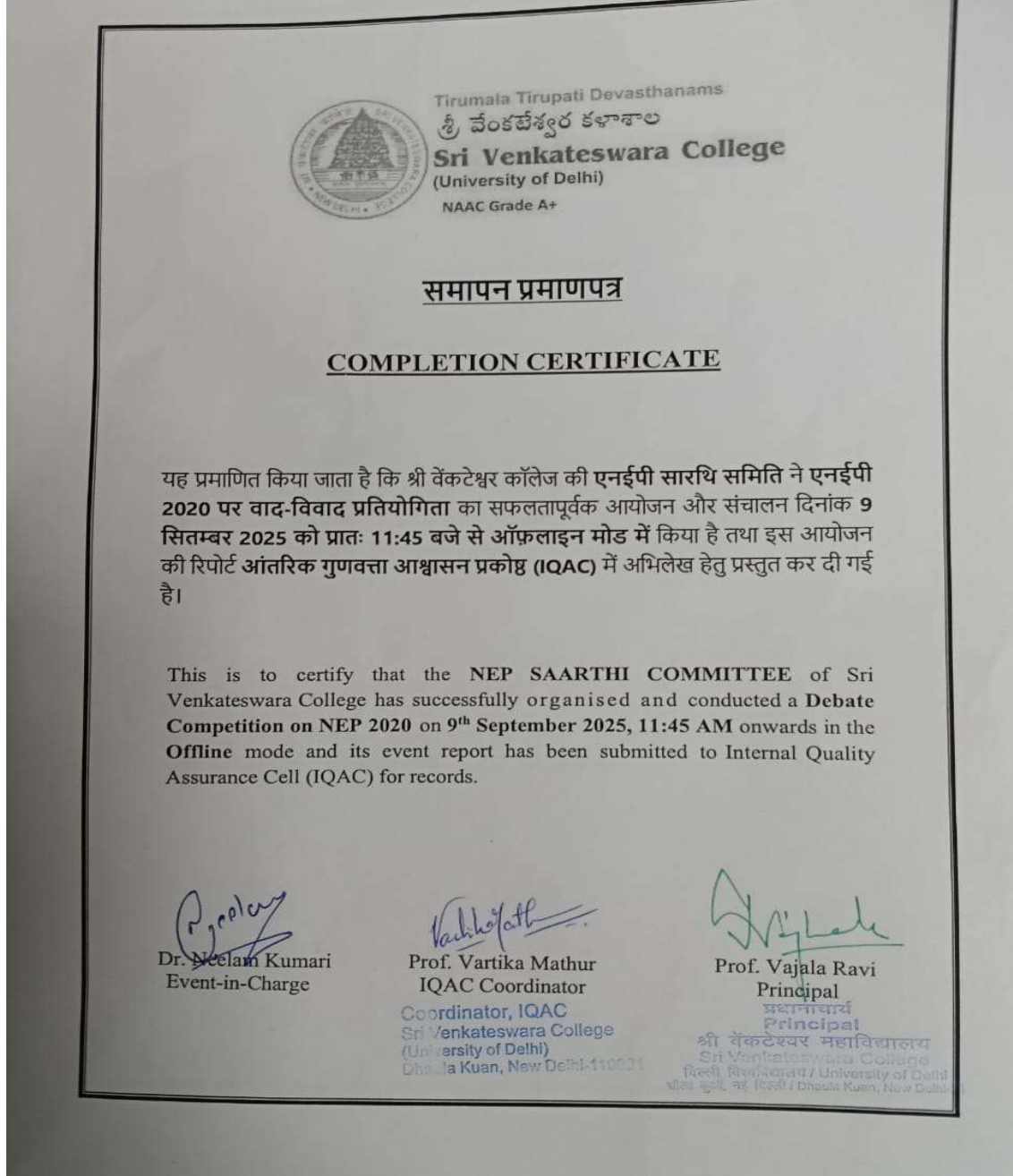

शांभवी व तनुश्री ने वाद-विवाद प्रतियोगिता में बाजी मारी

जासं, दक्षिणी दिल्ली: चार वर्षीय स्नातक कार्यक्रम विद्यार्थियों को बहुविषयक ज्ञान और शोध के अधिक अवसर देगा। साथ ही रुचि के अनुसार विषय बदलने का मौका भी देगा। पहले छात्र ने अपनी बात रखते हुए ऐसा कहा। अन्य छात्रा ने खंडन करते हुए कहा कि यह अतिरिक्त वर्ष छात्रों और अभिभावकों पर आर्थिक बोझ बढ़ाएगा। राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति 2020 के पक्ष और विपक्ष में कुछ इसी तरह छात्रों ने तीखी बहस की। मौका था डीयू के श्री वेंकटेश्वर कालेज में एनईपी सारथी समिति की ओर से बुधवार को हुई वाद-विवाद प्रतियोगिता का। राष्ट्रीय शिक्षा नीति-2020 विषय पर छात्रों ने वाद-विवाद के साथ पोस्टर मेकिंग प्रतियोगिता में भी भाग लिया।

विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग के निर्देशानुसार हुई इस प्रतियोगिता में कुल 145 प्रतिभागियों ने भाग लिया। प्रतियोगिता में प्रतिभागियों ने चार वर्षीय स्नातक कार्यक्रम का कार्यान्वयन, भारत में विदेशी विश्वविद्यालयों को बढ़ावा देना, आनलाइन शिक्षा की चुनौतियां जैसे मुद्दों पर बात रखी। बीए अर्थशास्त्र आनर्स द्वितीय वर्ष से आदित्य दास को सर्वश्रेष्ठ इंटरजेक्टर चुना गया, वहीं शांभवी और तनुश्री जोशी की टीम मंथन विजेता और वंदना शर्मा और अजय की टीम प्रेरणा उपविजेता रही। पोस्टर मेकिंग प्रतियोगिता में बीएससी लाइफ साइंसेज प्रथम वर्ष से श्रेयशी को पहला स्थान मिला, जबकि बीएससी आनर्स से अनुष्का जिंदल दूसरे स्थान पर रहीं।
